Curriculum Intent:

The curriculum for Spanish at Seva, creates confident communicators who use their skills in a foreign language to express their ideas, thoughts and opinions with respect for linguistic diversity. Pupils develop spoken and written skills to scaffold discussion alongside developing a strong grammatical knowledge and a breadth of vocabulary and structures. We ignite pupils' natural curiosity for the wider world. Lessons in Spanish are a window into the culture and society of communities beyond our doorstep and encourage pupils to understand the importance of recognising and celebrating cultural and linguistic differences. Pupils learn how important it is to accept and celebrate differences and how this can enrich lives.
