
Summer 1st half-term theme is: Jungles

English	Make animal masks and act out the story of Down in the Jungle. Write three things that you remember that happened in the story?	Research an animal you might find in the jungle; it could be an exotic insect or bird. Write some interesting facts that you find.	Write a letter inviting all the animals to a jungle party? Maths	Make a poster to help you remember counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.	Collect objects around your house to make arrays. You could use biscuits or pasta. Then write down the calculation of your array. $2+2+2+2-10$ or $5+5=10$ 	Find objects around your house and share them in to equal groups of 2 or 3. Use the picture below to help you.

Geography	Where in the world are jungles? Choose a jungle and write down some interesting facts.	Look at an atlas and find where Borneo is? What oceans and countries are nearby?	How many different habitats are there in the jungle? Make a list of the ones you find.
Art/DT	Make a miniature 3D model of a jungle. What material did you use to make it look 3D?	Research the different animals you would find in the jungle. Sketch some of these.	Look at pictures of the patterns on animal fur or skin. Some are stripy and some have patches. Draw and label some of the patterns in your book.
Science	Go on a Summer walk in your garden or local park. Take photos, write about or draw about the animals, insects or birds you spot. Remember to use your senses. What can you see, hear, smell or touch?	Can you name some animals that live in the jungle? Why do they live in the jungle? What is important about their habitat? (where they live)	What is growing in your garden? Take a trip a garden, park or garden centre. How many different types of plants and flowers can you spot? Can you name them? Can you draw and label the features of the plant or flower you have seen?
