Science:	Draw and label an image of the human heart. Write an explanation about how it works.	Create a playdough model of the human circulatory system. Use red and blue playdough to represent the arteries, veins and heart.	Draw a detailed diagram of a human heart. Label all the major arteries, veins and different parts of the heart. Write a short explanation of how the blood circulates in and out of the heart.
RE:	Create a poster outlining values that you feel are key to improving the world. Provide an explanation as to why you have chosen each value, for example, respect as God is within everyone and everything so we should treat all beings and our world with respect. You can create your poster on a piece of paper or on a computer.	What matters most to you? Create a list of the 10 things that matter most to you in your life numbered from 1 to 10 in order of importance. Give an explanation for your choices. Think about what influenced your choices- your faith, family, friends? Have a discussion about this with someone at home. What does their list look like and why? What are the similarities and differences? What is Guru Ji teaching us based on this story? Write a summary of what you think Guru Ji is teaching us through this story.
Geography	Create a fact sheet or quiz about the rainforests.	Pick a rainforest of your choice. Create a Powerpoint presentation about this rainforest. What is it called? What is it like? What animals and wildlife can you find there? Can you include some information video links in your presentation? Art or DT:	Draw a rainforest scene. Use a variety colouring pencils, pastels and felt tips. How does the brightness of the colours impact the final image?	Paint or draw and colour rainforest scene.
