Barcelona trip, Spain: 6th – 9th October 2022

Dear Parents/Carers,

The Spanish department is delighted to be able to offer Year 8 students the opportunity to take part in an educational visit to the city of Barcelona, Spain. The trip will run from **Thursday 6th October to Sunday 9th October 2022** (4 days and 3 nights).

This is a very exciting project, which will enable the students involved to gain an invaluable insight into Spanish culture and language. In our experience, this type of trip is an extremely successful tool to enhance your child's language skills and confidence as well as their understanding of the rich culture that the country has to offer.

Our students will also have the opportunity to take part in Spanish conversations with locals to enrich their fluency and confidence in the subject. Furthermore, activities such as a guided tour of the famous Camp Nou football stadium, the "Basilica de la Sagrada Familia", a journey through Barcelona's historic Gothic Quarter and opportunities to sample the famous food that Spain has to offer will form part of the itinerary. Students will also have an opportunity to spend time exploring the more modern side of the city.

The trip is being booked through NST Travel, the UK's leading educational travel company for schools with more than 50 years' experience. The price of the trip per paying person is approximately **£570.00, price will vary depending on numbers and monthly payments will be set on ParentPay**, which is inclusive of flights, transfers, accommodation, meals-half board-, all daytime and evening activities and all travel arrangements **plus an additional £50.00 flight contingency**. Please note that places are limited (only 40) and will be allocated on a **first come first served basis**. There will also be four members of staff accompanying the students on this trip.

If you wish to secure your child's place on the trip, **a deposit of £150 is required to be made via ParentPay (payment item as 'Barcelona Trip - October 2022) by no later than 7th May 2022**. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the Finance Officer at the earliest opportunity, who will be able to provide you with a barcode to enable you to pay at a Pay Point store.

Please note that cash or cheque payments will not be accepted by the school. Please also complete the consent forms (2 pages) attached to confirm booking and payment of the deposit. **Please note, if we fail to secure the spaces allocated then unfortunately, the trip will not be able to go ahead.**

It is your responsibility to ensure that your child has a **valid passport and, if required, an up-to-date visa**. Please remember the required passport must be valid for 6 months from the departure date.
