Welcome to the first community newsletter from Bowmer + Kirkland regarding the refurbishment and extension of Seva School in Coventry.

# **Project Information**

The project will include a two-storey extension to Eden House incorporating a new sports hall. In addition, a single storey extension to Link House will feature a new Diwan Hall, alongside other refurbishment works to Eden House/ Link House.

We began on site last month, with full completion aiming for Autumn 2025. Earthworks have started, reducing the ground levels to allow construction of a sports pitch and MUGA. Demolition of existing internal finishes and installation of new site services will start soon.

We always aim to keep all disruption to a minimum. As such, cleaning vehicles will remove any mud on the highways and deliveries are scheduled to avoid school drop off and pick up times.
