Core subjects

- The core subjects are studied by all students and they will sit a GCSE in each subject, the core subject offer is as follows:
- English Language
- English Literature
- Mathematics
- Science (Combined or Triple)
- Religious Studies
- Non-GCSE core subjects:
- PE and PHSE all students study these statutory subjects, they are not examined



Science

- We offer all students combined Science
- Students will receive two GCSE's in Science and will study all 3 Science's
- A select group of students will be offered the Triple Science route
- Students receive a GCSE in each of the Sciences
- Triple science has more content and is not suited towards all learners

Flightpath blue

- This flightpath gives students the opportunity to complete the full suite of EBACC subjects. Students will study the following subjects along with the following choices
- Core subjects:
- English literature/ language, Maths, Science, RE ,Spanish
- PE and PSHE non exam subjects

Option 1, pupils will pick one of these two subjects: Geography or History Option 2, pupils will rank two subjects in order of preference and will study one of these subjects: Business Studies, Computer

Science, Sociology, Art, CAMNAT Sport



Flightpath orange

- This flightpath gives students more freedom to pick subjects of their choice however does not have the option of studying Spanish
- Students will study the following core subjects:
- English literature/language, Maths, Science, RE
- Core PE and PSHE non exam

Option subjects, pupils will rank five subjects in order of preference and will study three of these subjects: Geography, History, Business Studies, Computer Science, Sociology, Art, CAMNAT Sport



Flightpath red

- This flightpath allows students to complete most of the EBACC suite however Spanish is optional
- Students on this flightpath will study the following core subjects:
- English literature/language, Maths, Science, RE
- Core PE and PSHE non exam

What is a CAMNAT qualification?

- Cambridge Nationals (CAMNAT's) are vocational qualifications that are designed specifically for 14-16 year olds
- They are designed to complement GCSE's by providing students with access to the vocational sector
- Students are assessed partly from an exam as well as practical tasks as part of the assessment
- Cambridge nationals have clear progression routes to A-Level, Apprenticeships or further advanced vocational qualifications
- The qualifications are graded at level 1 (grades 1-3) or level 2 (grades 4 -9)



Things to consider when picking your options

Do:

- Pick subjects you are interested in
- Try to ensure you have a good balance of subjects
- Read through GCSE specifications carefully before making your choices

• Do not:

- Pick subjects because your friends are picking them
- Pick subjects because you get on well with the teacher
- Pick a subject that you have not researched
