


Seva School Homework for Autumn 1st half-term 2022

Science:	Create a poster about a material of your choice and its properties.	Research useful materials and their properties. Choose an object in your home and draw it. Label the materials used to make it and explain why these properties were used.	Create a fact-file about a scientist who made a new material. Research the scientist and their life, such as when they lived, and what they did. Find out about this new material; its properties and how it is useful. Include pictures and diagrams to add interest.

RE	Explain what Christians believe about God.	Collect evidence from people at home (3 or 4 quotes from friends or family) about whether or not they believe in God and why. Ask about how this affects their life and explain this in your writing.	Compare what Christians believe about God with another religion. What are the similarities? Are there any differences?
History	Create a 'Wanted Poster, which includes a description of an Anglo-Saxon criminal. State what crime has been committed and what the punishment is.	Find out about an Anglo-Saxon king that reigned during this period. Present your facts in an interesting and exciting way.	Write a job advert for an Anglo-Saxon warrior. Try to include as many non-negotiables as you can. What are the main responsibilities of the job? What type of person are you looking for?
Art or DT	Find out what Anglo-Saxon's wore. Draw and label a picture of an Anglo-Saxon. What is he/she wearing?	Draw portraits of the last Anglo-Saxon kings? You could use pencils, charcoal or paint.	Create your own Sutton Hoo helmet/mask using materials you can reuse. You could also decorate it using tin foil or buttons. Look at the one found at Sutton Hoo for an example. (It can be any size).
