Sadly, we lost a much-loved member of our primary teaching team last term. Mrs. Victoria Woodward, who taught Class 2S, passed away suddenly after a short illness. She was a tremendously kind teacher who lived the SEVA values in all that she touched. Mrs Woodward taught every child like they were her own and through her projects linked to PHSE, music and singing she always made learning fun and memorable. Whether Mrs Woodward was at school upholding the Sikh faith values or at Church running messy club she was the epitome of service. Through reminding staff and students alike that: it was okay, not to be okay, she made sure feelings were shared and an honest reflection sought to solve any problem, no matter how big or small.

The funeral service for Mrs Woodward will take place on Friday 21st April from 2pm at St. Nicholas Church in Nuneaton. In respect of the overwhelming affection, we all have for her and her family at this most tragic of times, we will be closing the school to students in primary at 12pm. Students in Years R, 1 and 2 and those in receipt of FSM in years 3 to 6 will be provided with a packed lunch to take home with them. Students in primary being picked up at this time can be collected from the usual point of the silver gate and their afternoon attendance mark will not be adversely impacted. If you have a child(ren) in primary who cannot be picked up at this time because they can only go home with a sibling(s) in secondary and/or they can only go home on the coach, they will be kept in school until the end of the school day as usual.
