Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you that, after careful consideration, we are having to make a small increase in the cost of school meals. There are significantly higher costs that all schools are now facing for gas and electricity along with food and non-food inflationary costs increasing. At Seva School we have not had a price per meal increase since 2019. Overall, the costs will increase by 20p. The price per meal will be £2.70. This increase will take effect from 27<sup>th</sup> February 2023.

Healthy school meals, cooked on the premises, are available each day. There is a fortnightly rolling menu detailing each day's main course, salad and dessert available on our website. See link:

The Government have continued to support the Universal Infant Free School meals project and this means that all children from Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 can be provided with a school meal free of charge.

If your child is in Years 3 to 11, they can also have a free school meal if you are in receipt of certain allowances. Applications for FSMs must be renewed annually.
