Dear parent/ carer,

As we approach the end of the second week of the GCSE examinations I would like to comment on how impressed we have been with the pupils during the exams so far. Pupils have shown real resilience and a determination to succeed, pupil behaviour and conduct during the exams so far has been exceptional, they have done the whole Seva community proud.

As of Friday 26th May, pupils will only need to be in school when they have an exam. It is imperative that pupils are in on the day of any remaining exams and punctual, being in school at 8:15am for morning exams and if they have just an afternoon exam, they should be in school for 1:00pm. If pupils only have an exam in the morning, they will be free to go home once the exam has finished. On days that pupils do not have exams we are happy for pupils to revise independently at home. If your child uses the school bus and only has an exam in the morning and needs to use the school bus to get home, we will provide them a quiet space to revise for the rest of the day under supervision of staff. If you would like to continue sending your child in to revise in school, we will also provide them a quiet space to revise. Teachers are still available in school and via email to assist with revision should pupils have any questions or require support they can contact teachers. Some subjects will also be putting on bespoke revision sessions the day before exams when there are no other exams taking place, specific information about these revision sessions will be sent out in due course.

We would like to take this opportunity to wish the year 11's the best of luck for their remaining exams, I will be sending out information about a final assembly for year 11's after half term. This will hopefully be a nice event to celebrate the end of their time at Seva, although they will remain part of the Seva community for life. Please can I also remind parents and students to get reply slips for the end of year prom to Mrs Clay as soon as possible, payments can be made via parent pay.
