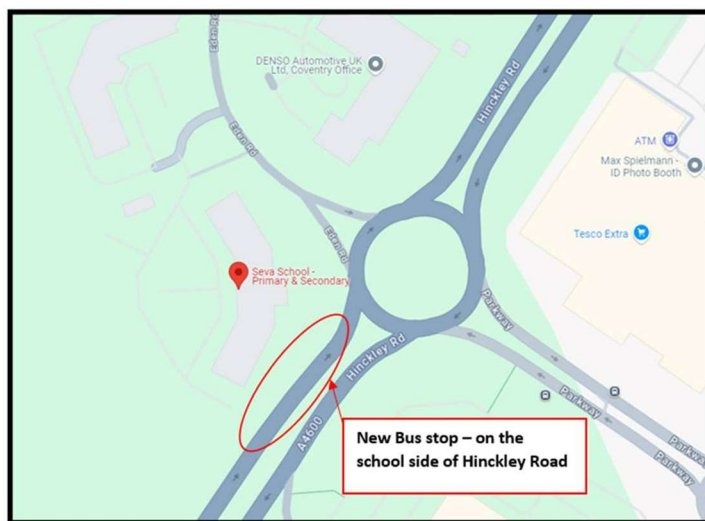
Dear Parent/Carers,

Further to the parent survey conducted last academic year and in response to the feedback you provided, we can now share that as of Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> September pupils using the No'8 bus will no longer need to manoeuvre across the Hinckley Road in order to access the bus. Coventry City Council (CCC) met with National Express and Transport for West Midlands (TfWM) to raise our concerns about pupils needing to cross the Hinckley Road to access the bus stop.

Subsequently, it has been agreed that a new "temporary" bus stop will be installed on the north-western side of Hinckley Road, south of Hinckley Road's junction with Eden Road. It will be on the school side of Hinckley Road. Although temporary, if the bus stop is used as expected, they will consider requesting the bus stop be made permanent and in use during our school term times.

The new 'temporary' bus stop (as per the plan below) has been installed by CCC. The bus stop will cater for pupils travelling in all directions including towards the City Centre. Pupils travelling towards the City Centre would need to stay on the bus as it travels to its final destination stop, and await until it turns around to travel towards the City Centre.

We would be grateful if you could share this information with your child(ren). **Please emphasise that the bus stop must be used responsibly and crossing the Hinckley Road is no longer an option.** We believe this is a very important step towards ensuring the safety of our pupils as well as the safety of the motorists travelling along the dual carriageway.
