English: <i>Stories</i> <i>Recount</i> <i>Explanation</i>	Create a storyboard of a Greek myth you have read. Use pictures and captions. If you prefer, retell the story or write your own version.	Write a character description about a mythical creature that you have created. How does it behave? Where does it live? What does it eat? Where did it come from? Does it have any enemies? What has it done to the heroes that have come across it?	Find out as much as you can about Archimedes' life and use this information to write a short biography about him.

Maths: <i>Problem Solving</i> <i>Reasoning</i>	Sid the Snake has these numbers: 2 9 1 6 He says the smallest number he can make with them is 2916 . Is he correct? Make all possible numbers and write them in order. What is the largest number he could make would be. Now do the same with the digits 3 2 9 1 6	I'm thinking of a number. I halve it. I divide it by 7. I subtract 4. My answer is 4 What number was I thinking of? Explain your answer. Make up three of your own.	My number has four digits. It is smaller than 6000 but bigger than 5000. The hundreds digit is smaller than 7 but bigger than 5. The tens digit is an odd number smaller than 5 but bigger than 1. The units digit is in the 3 times table and is bigger than 4 but smaller than 8. What's my number?

Science: <i>Sound</i>	Use the following link to find out about sound. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zgffr82/articles/zstr2nb Explain how sounds are made and heard.	Using a shoe box and different elastic bands, make an instrument. Which elastic bands make a higher pitched sound? Try the elastic bands on a different sized box. What happens to the pitch? Write up your findings and include labelled diagrams.	Partially fill a jar or bottle with water - strike or blow across the top. How does the sound change when you add more water? Make a straw oboe; how does the length of tube affect the sound? You will need: glass jars and different coloured water, wooden spoon, plastic drinking straws. Challenge: Can you make an instrument that will play a scale? Write up your findings and include labelled diagrams.

Remember the features of a letter: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • introduction • main body • conclusion 	Write a biography about an inspirational leader. Art or DT	Design and make a throne for a Greek God. The design should reflect their powers. <i>Lollypop sticks are a good resource for this task.</i>	Make some Ancient Greek bread. What is it called? Does it have any powers?
