There is only the One Lord and Master, but there are two paths, by which conflict increases.

All follow these two paths, by the Hukam of the Lord's Command; the world is born, only to die.

They chant the Ambrosial Word of His Bani, savoring it with their tongues.

Savoring it with their tongues, they thirst for the Naam; they are a sacrifice to the Word of the Guru's Shabad.

Touching the philosopher's stone, they become the philosopher's stone, which transforms lead into gold; O Lord, they become pleasing to your mind.

I am hungry and thirsty for wealth; how will I be able to go to the Lord's Court?

ਸਤਿਗੁਰ ਪੁਛਉ ਜਾਇ ਨਾਮੂ ਧਿਆਇਸਾ ਜੀਉ॥

I shall go and ask the True Guru, and meditate on the Naam, the Name of the Lord.

Principal's Message Mrs. S. Sanghera

On Tuesday 21st November, Seva School had the honour of welcoming the CEO of Khalsa Aid International, Ravi Singh and local Coventry representative of Khalsa Aid, Gurmeet Singh. They shared information about the work of the charity and the impact it has on people in Britain and around the world irrespective of their identity or background. They talked to students and staff about the 3 key principles of the Sikh faith, Vand Chhakna, Kirat Karni and Naam Japna and how these teachings influence, motivate, and drive their charity mission to serve others.

Ravi and Gurmeet shared their experiences of travelling to several countries, whether this be due to a natural disaster or war. They explained how the charity provides food supplies, water, and amenities to those in crisis, not just in the short term, but for their recovery over time. Their work is an example of selfless service, kindness and courage - all virtues close to the heart of our school. It was great to see our students' making links to these and feeling inspired.

Ravi was impressed with the simran and shabads (hymns) shared by students in primary. He particularly liked the questions about what inspired him to start the charity and how this linked to our Seva standards and virtues. He said he had attended a Nagar Kirtan (walk from Gurdwara Sahibs to Gurdwara Sahibs in a locality) and came across a stall raising funds to support the victims of the war in Kosovo at the time. This sparked his interest in the work of volunteers and charity workers. Students in secondary asked Ravi about what he would have been had he not become the CEO of Khalsa Aid, he shared his interest in travelling the world and cars. Ravi and Gurmeet expressed how impressed they were with the respect and engagement shown by our staff and students.

Finally, Ravi explained how one of the cornerstones of the Sikh faith of "Sarbat dha Bhala" inspired the key message of his charity which is: "Recognise the Whole Human Race as ONE".

BANDI CHHOR WORKSHOPS






We are immensely proud of Ishanni in year 3 for the following accomplishment shared with us by her family:

The first-ever football kit for the Moon revealed today...in time for the 2035/36 season.

England Lioness and Women's Euros 2022 winner Beth England joins two inspirational schoolgirls for a football kit reveal in anticipation of the first-ever football match on the Moon, as children across the UK competed to design the first official Moon United kit.

The Institution of Engineering and Technology (IET) with the help of Beth England has today unveiled the world's first football home and away kits for the lunar footballers of the future following a campaign in which engineers predicted humans could be playing a competitive game of football on the moon as early as 2035*. The big reveal follows a nationwide competition by the IET for school children aged 4 to 13 to design the first-ever 'Moon United' home and away kit — with the aim of challenging outdated perceptions of engineering and showing children how they could combine a passion for football and space with a Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM) related career. With bold and eye-catching futuristic designs that would rival any Premier League club's shirt, the kits were designed by two talented winners, one of the winners was Ishaani.

Based in Coventry and winner of the 4–7-year-old category, Ishaani created a bold space-themed shirt, with striking colours and playful solar system illustrations. According to Ishaani the Earth and Sun featured are meant to give positivity to the game, and the shooting stars represent the speed and spirit of football. The judges 'loved the colourful design and the smart idea to turn the planet Saturn into a football with rings as the central focus point.'

Competition winner Ishaani said: "I am so happy to be a winner and can't wait to wear my shirt. One day I hope I'll get to play football on the Moon with my sister. I'd love that."




