#### **PE Uniform**

We have the opening of the brand new 3G pitch during the autumn term and then Eden House during the summer term to look forward to. The 3G pitch has very specific requirements for its use and for this reason we have made a change to the PE uniform. To be allowed access to the facility, your child will have to be wearing trainers suitable for the 3G Astro turf detailed in the following images:



The following list of stores, although not exclusive, are known to sell the trainers with the correct grip suitable for a 3G Astro turfed pitch. The trainers should also come with a plain black shoe bag to catch any remnants of the pitch ending up in school, cars, and homes.

# **Digital devices**

Mobile phones, smart watches, ear plugs etc. will be collected on entry to school and secured safely in a locked cupboard ready for collection at the end of the school day. If any of these items are found after this point, they will be kept in school for 5 school days and returned to either yourself or your child on the morning of the sixth day. All IT devices in school used by staff and students are monitored by a filtering system called SENSO.
