RE: Update on Phase 2 of the Capital Build Programme. Arrangements to support the BIG move from the current MIRI Building to the new PIRI Building.

As you may be aware the opening of the brand new, multi-million-pound, purpose-built facilities has been a long wait for Seva School and one that has needed tremendous resilience and patience on behalf of all those dedicated to achieving this aspiration. We are becoming ever closer to reaching our goal of having two, state of the art buildings, encompassing a Sports Hall, two MUGA pitches, a 3G pitch and Educational Divan Hall, fully opened in September 2025.

In January 2024, we announced the completion of Phase 1, with the opening of the 3G pitch and the first of the two MUGA pitches. We are now delighted to announce that we are nearing the completion of Phase 2. This will include the handing over of the Sports Hall and entire PIRI Building. Phase 2 is currently on course to be handed over to us on Monday 3rd June 2024.

The date means we will be decanting from the MIRI Building to the PIRI Building over the May half term holidays. To support the safe and timely transition from one building to the other, we are required to put in place two days of home-learning for our students. **The dates for these will be Friday 24th May 2024 and Monday 3rd June 2024.** We have shared this news with you at the earliest possible date, in order to give you enough time to make arrangements. We have kept the number of days of home learning to just two in order to minimise disruption. Students will be sent home on Thursday 23rd May with packs of work for the two days. We will not, unfortunately, have access to IT to run Teams from Friday 24th May to Tuesday 4th June 2024. There is no doubt that the pressures associated with, an expansion in a timeframe shortened to deliver permanent and purpose-built facilities, whilst minimising the impact on curriculum and outcomes, is open to unforeseen delays. Therefore, a delay in any way to Phase 2 being delivered on time is something we would have to take into consideration and be prepared for. If there is any change to the above, you will be informed as soon as possible and onsite learning on the dates specified will be immediately resumed. We would of course be grateful of your understanding in this event.

Temporary adaptations to support the BIG move:

The following information outlines what we would welcome your support with, in order to make the transition run as smoothly as possible. They are short-term adaptations that will be in place, whilst we await the full refurbishment of the MIRI Building in September 2025.

Temporary Traffic Management Plan for Phase 2 – This will come into effect Tuesday 4th June 2024. We will communicate this plan in more detail along with an opportunity for you to attend a presentation during May.





Temporary Kitchen and Revised Menu - From Tuesday 4th June 2024 to the end of July 2025 the school will operate a temporary menu that has been revised to reflect this change. It will then be revised again for September 2024. The menus will be available on our website for you to refer to in due course.

Additional Portacabins - We will have two portacabin classrooms set up on the car park at the PIRI Building temporarily until July 2025. They will be put in over the summer break. They are needed to ensure that we have adequate space to accommodate growing numbers whilst the entire build is being completed.

Primary Classrooms – Years 6, 5, 4 will remain in the current classrooms and will be joined by Year 2. EYFS, Year 1 and Year 3 will be moving to the PIRI Building until the end of this academic year.

We greatly value your support in this stage of the development. **To mark this momentous** milestone, we would like to invite you to an open evening on Friday 21st June 2024. The PIRI Building will be open from 3:30pm to 6:30pm for you to enjoy a tour of the facilities with your family and friends.

Finally, it is important to acknowledge the tremendous amount of hard work put in by everyone involved in this capital build project. It has been carried out with the utmost dedication, commitment, and enthusiasm to give all our wonderful pupils, their loyal families, and our loving community something to be very proud of. Thank you.
